APPLICATION

Stir paint thoroughly. Intermix containers for uniformity. Apply product when surface, air and product temperatures are between 50-90°F. Apply with a premium-quality brush, a synthetic roller cover or airless spray (2000 PSI, .015"-.019" tip). Thinning not required. Some deep or bright colors, surface conditions and application techniques may impact coverage and require multiple coats to achieve your optimal coverage. Priming: This product can be used to prime patched areas, unpainted surfaces and lightly stained areas before applying it as the finish coat. For best results on heavily stained areas, use a coat of an appropriate stain-blocking primer. For drastic color changes or deep, vivid colors, prime with this product or an appropriate tintable primer for your optimal color accuracy and coverage.
